Major Information (CIP: 51.0913)

This is a “Specialized Admissions & Limited Enrollment” major. This means that with earning the A.A. degree, and successfully completing each of the required pre-requisite courses, with the required final grades, and having the required overall GPA (meaning ALL college-level courses ever taken at any institution, at any time, no “grade forgiveness” calculated), that you are qualified to complete the special application process to this major. **Meeting the minimum requirements for admission DOES NOT guarantee admission to the program.** *If not formally admitted to the Athletic Training program, students MUST contact the FSU Admissions Office to be considered for another major option at FSU.*

Transfer students applying for a Spring semester admit to FSU (most common):** Admitted students MUST enroll in ATR 1800 in their first Spring term at FSU to undergo the additional selection/formal admission process to possibly continue in the program in the next Fall term. ATR 1800 is only offered during Spring semesters. Major courses (outside of ATR 1800) are restricted to formally accepted students.

Dual enrolling in ATR 1800 in a final spring semester at TSC (less common) :** Transfer students apply for the following Fall semester at FSU. Notification of admittance to BOTH the University and the Athletic Training program would only occur AFTER formal admission decisions are made that Summer (typically mid-August). Students MUST indicate they are dual enrolled in ATR 1800 in the upcoming/current schedule section of their FSU admission application for a Fall admit. Students must have ALL prerequisites completed, including the 2.50 overall GPA, to protect their enrollment in ATR 1800. Seats in ATR 1800 cannot be guaranteed. If unable to dual enroll in ATR 1800, students would need to reapply for a future Spring term admit to FSU.
