The Elementary Education BS/MS pathway is designed to prepare you to teach children at the kindergarten through sixth grade levels in all content areas. Our program is unique in that we focus on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) education, recognizing the importance of math and science taught in an integrated curriculum instead of in isolation. Through extensive field experiences with students of varying socioeconomic backgrounds and grade levels, you will be prepared to work with culturally, linguistically, and academically diverse student populations. Our coursework is grounded in research-based “best practices” that prepare you to be a leader in your field and community. **The BS/MS pathway requires two years of upper-division undergraduate coursework plus one additional year of graduate coursework.**
