The English Education BS/MS pathway is designed to prepare students to teach English in secondary school settings (grades 6 - 12). The program includes required coursework in literature, linguistics, composition and rhetoric, and speech, as well as coursework in teaching methodology, including reading, writing, multiple literacies, and English for second language learners. **The BS/MS pathway requires two years of upper-division undergraduate coursework plus one additional year of graduate coursework.**
